## 2020 *Bohan Dillon* Pinot Noir

David Hirsch was inspired to create the *Bohan-Dillon* Pinot Noir as an homage to the great *village* wines of France: a wine full of place and personality, made with the same care and attention as the top wines, yet at a good price. The Hirsch Vineyards *Bohan-Dillon* Pinot Noir is produced using the exact same winemaking methods and with the same attention to detail as our other pinots, thereby ensuring a wine of great quality, traditional varietal character, and sense of place.

The 2020 vintage is a blend of 73% Hirsch Vineyards Pinot Noir and 27% Hellenthal Vineyard Pinot Noir, the only vineyard contiguous to Hirsch. In the *Bohan-Dillon* you will find the ultimate summer red, the wine for Tuesday night pizza or for entertaining anytime – made with integrity and precision.

David Hirsch wrote of the *Bohan-Dillon*: "Bells will ring and the bears will growl 'Hallelujah!' as the elegance and finesse of a real wine from a real place, made by real folks who actually live on site, washes down the throat."

The 2020 *Bohan-Dillon* is fresh and energetic, with notes of sweet strawberries, orange peel and bergamot. The impressive tannins that are a hallmark of the 2020 vintage are present here, making this a more structured *Bohan-Dillon* than in past years. We recommend decanting before drinking, and this is certainly a wine that can go the distance in the cellar.
